Non-emergency public transportation is available for all residents of Waldo County with regularly scheduled routes to Belfast, Bangor, Augusta, Waterville, and Rockland.

Fares range from \$1 - \$5 for a one-way trip. Elderly customers that cannot use the regularly scheduled bus route system have the option of paying \$0.44 cents per mile for trips to medical appointments. Any transportation provided for DHHS certified eligible clients is free through our Fee Waiver Program.

Rides must be scheduled at least 48 hours in advance. To schedule, call **338-4769** or **1-800-439-7865** (toll free).



The Belfast Shopper is a shuttle-style bus service that makes a continuous loop through Belfast on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. Bus stops are marked with blue and yellow signs and passengers may be dropped off and picked up anywhere along the route. Passengers pay a \$1.00 one-way fare when boarding the bus. No appointment is necessary.



Ride with Pride is a voucher program that aims to better integrate seniors and people with disabilities into their communities. Once approved, participants can purchase transportation vouchers at half the cost of their value.

MAINECARE TRANSPORTATION

Waldo County Transportation provides rides for MaineCare members to their medical appointments. The rides are arranged through a separate program of Waldo Community Action Partners, called Mid-Coast Connector.

Mid-Coast Connector is the MaineCare broker for Region 5 (Waldo, Lincoln, Sagadahoc, and Knox counties, as well as the municipalities of Brunswick and Harspwell.) Your ride may not always be provided by Waldo County Transportation. In some cases, it may be another area transportation provider or a taxi.

Appointments need to be made with the nearest medical provider defined by MaineCare. Call Mid-Coast Connector early, as prior authorizations take time to get approval. Same-day appointments will be accepted for urgent care when verified with the attending physician.

Call Mid-Coast Connector at **(855) 930-7900** to make your appointment for MaineCare transportation to your medical appointments at least 2 business days in advance.



Looking for a way to give back? WCAP is always in need of reliable volunteer drivers to transport people to medical appointments and family visits using their own vehicles. The program is a valuable service to the community and directly improves the quality of life for many of our friends and neighbors. All WCAP volunteer drivers receive tax-exempt reimbursement for miles traveled at \$0.44 cents per mile and free training in CPR, first-aid, passenger assistance, communication, DHHS child transport, securing child car seats, and emergency vehicle evacuation.



If you are unable to afford WCTP's rates and you are income-eligible, you may opt to complete an application certification process for a fee waiver.
