



Q5 The number of children in my household that are 5 years or younger





Q6 The number of children in my household that are ages 6 - 17 years of age





Q10 What language do you primarily speak at home?







Q34 Do you or someone in your household have the following support systems available when needed? (Please check all that apply)





Q35 Are members of your household connected to others in the community in the following ways: (Please check all that apply)











Q39 Do you have access to enough food to feed your family? If not, why? (Please check all that apply)












